Juventus' proud home European record took a knock with a defeat and a draw in their last two fixtures and, having gone down 2-1 at Real Madrid CF last time out, they need a better result in the reverse fixture.

- The Italian champions started with two draws in Group B, 1-1 away to FC København and 2-2 at home to Galatasaray AŞ. Madrid – seeking a tenth European Cup – won their first two games – 6-1 at Galatasaray and 4-0 at home to København, Cristiano Ronaldo adding two goals to his matchday one hat-trick.
- The Portuguese forward scored twice more as Madrid overcame ten-man Juve on matchday three to open up a five-point lead in the standings and leave their opponents lagging in third place.

### Previous meetings

- These two teams have between them lifted this trophy four times since the onset of the UEFA Champions League from a total of seven appearances in the final.
- They met in the 1998 final in Amsterdam when a 66th-minute Predrag Mijatović goal ended the Merengues' 32-year wait for their seventh European Cup title.
- The teams have faced each other 15 times – all in the European Cup – with home advantage proving key: Madrid's home record is W5 L2 while Juventus' is W5 L1.
- Before this season they last met in the 2008/09 group stage when the Italian team won home and away. Juve triumphed 2-1 in Turin, with Alessandro Del Piero and Amauri on target before Ruud van Nistelrooy got one back. Two weeks later Del Piero scored twice at the Santiago Bernabéu in a 2-0 victory.
- The lineups at the Stadio Olimpico on 21 October 2008 were:  
**Juventus:** Manninger, Grygera, Legrottaglie (Mellberg 46), Chiellini, Molinaro, Marchionni, Sissoko, Marchisio (Salihamidžić 37), Nedvěd, Amauri (Iaquinta 78), Del Piero.  
**Madrid:** Casillas, Sergio Ramos, Pepe, Cannavaro, Heinze, Van der Vaart (Drenthe 76), Gago, Sneijder, Raúl, Van Nistelrooy, Higuaín (Robben 54).
- It was one of five successive Juventus home victories against the Spanish giants – in the other game, the first between the teams, Madrid won a 1961/62 European Champion Clubs' Cup quarter-final first leg 1-0. Juventus did the same in Madrid but then lost 3-1 in a Paris replay.
- Juventus have come out on top overall on the last three occasions the clubs have been paired together. The 1962 defeat was one of only two inflicted by Spanish visitors on Juventus – the other was a 1-0 reverse against RC Deportivo La Coruña in the 2003/04 round of 16 second leg which ensured a 2-0 aggregate defeat. Overall at home Juve's record is W12 D5 L2.
- The Italian club overturned a 2-1 first-leg defeat against Madrid in the 2002/03 semi-finals, winning 3-1 at home. In the final, the Bianconeri drew 0-0 with an AC Milan side coached by Carlo Ancelotti, who had an earlier spell in charge of Juve, after extra time. A 3-2 loss on penalties denied the Turin club a third European Cup.
- Madrid had made 14 visits to Italy before their first victory, beating AS Roma 2-1 in the 2001/02 first group stage. They have failed to win on their last six visits and their last success was also against Roma, 3-0 in the 2004/05 group stage. Their overall away record against Serie A sides is W4 D7 L17.

### Match background

- Making their return to the competition last season after a three-year absence, Juventus reached the quarter-finals where they went down 2-0 home and away to FC Bayern München. The defeat ended Juve's run of six wins and five draws in 11 home European fixtures since Bayern won a matchday six encounter in December 2009.
- In the group stage the Bianconeri drew 1-1 with FC Shakhtar Donetsk in their first European game at the new Juventus Stadium. They followed up with home wins over FC Nordsjælland 4-0 and Chelsea FC 3-0 before a 2-0 second-leg success against Celtic FC completed a 5-0 aggregate win in the last 16.
- Liga runners-up in 2012/13, Madrid have scored in all their last 19 UEFA Champions League away fixtures, losing only four. Last season they were Group D runners-up behind Borussia Dortmund. They won away at AFC Ajax 4-1, drew 1-1 at Manchester City FC and lost 2-1 in Dortmund. They also triumphed 2-1 at Manchester United FC in the round of 16.
- They met Dortmund again in the semi-finals when a 4-1 reverse in Germany was Madrid's third loss in their six away fixtures. They won the home leg 2-0 but bowed out 4-3 on aggregate.

### Team ties

- Ancelotti, twice a European Cup winner with AC Milan as a player before coaching victories in 2003 (against Juve)

and 2007, coached Juventus between 1999 and 2001, with Antonio Conte captaining the side.

- Real Madrid assistant coach Zinédine Zidane played for Juve between 1996 and 2001 and was a team-mate of Conte.
- Xabi Alonso scored Liverpool FC's equalising third goal in the 3-3 draw against Ancelotti's Milan in the 2005 UEFA Champions League final in Istanbul. Andrea Pirlo missed from the spot as the English side won on penalties.
- Alonso and Pirlo were again midfield rivals two years later as Ancelotti's Milan defeated Liverpool 2-1 in the Athens final.
- Iker Casillas, Álvaro Arbeloa, Sergio Ramos, Xabi Alonso and Fernando Llorente were in Spain's victorious 2010 FIFA World Cup squad.
- Casillas saved two spot kicks as Spain defeated Gianluigi Buffon and Giorgio Chiellini's Italy 4-2 on penalties in Vienna in the UEFA EURO 2008 quarter-final. The game was goalless after 120 minutes; Ramos also played while Alonso and Arbeloa were substitutes.
- Alonso scored a penalty against Buffon for Spain in a Bari friendly on 10 August 2011. Italy, who also fielded Leonardo Bonucci, Chiellini, Claudio Marchisio and Pirlo, won 2-1.
- The same Juventus quintet plus Andrea Barzagli were defeated 4-0 by a Spain team captained by Casillas and including Ramos, Alonso and Arbeloa, in the UEFA EURO 2012 final in Kyiv. Angelo Ogbonna and Sebastian Giovinco were unused Italy substitutes.
- Giovinco and Pirlo scored in the shoot-out along with Ramos as Spain defeated Italy 7-6 on penalties in the 2013 FIFA Confederations Cup semi-final in Fortaleza after a goalless 120 minutes. Bonucci missed the decisive penalty.
- Llorente scored five times – twice at the Santiago Bernabéu – against Madrid in his total of 85 goals for Athletic Club. He was on the winning side just once in 17 encounters with the Merengues, Athletic losing the other 16 games.
- Carlos Tévez and Ángel Di María are team-mates for Argentina.
- Paul Pogba and Raphaël Varane both made their France debuts on 22 March 2013 in a World Cup qualifier against Georgia at the Stade de France. Karim Benzema also played in that 3-1 victory.
- Martín Cáceres played in Spain for RC Recreativo de Huelva, FC Barcelona and Sevilla FC. He scored once against Madrid but lost all five encounters with the Merengues.

- Fabio Quagliarella, out since suffering a thigh injury on 15 October, returned to action in Saturday's 1-0 win at Parma FC.
- Juventus have kept three successive Serie A clean sheets – they had not previously managed two in a row this season.
- Leonardo Bonucci's goal in the 2-0 win against Genoa CFC on 27 October was his first since April 2012.
- Juve suffered a first defeat of the season on 20 October, conceding four times in the final 14 minutes to lose 4-2 at ACF Fiorentina. It was the first time they had shipped four goals under Antonio Conte.
- Juventus have found the net in 24 successive Serie A encounters, since a 1-0 loss to AS Roma on 16 February.
- Mirko Vučinić and Stephan Lichtsteiner have not played since suffering muscle injuries on matchday two. Simone Pepe has not played a competitive game since 17 November 2012 because of a thigh injury.
- Gianluigi Buffon is Italy's most capped player, surpassing Fabio Cannavaro with his 137th appearance in a 2-2 draw in Denmark on 11 October.
- Andrea Pirlo has been nominated for the 2014 FIFA Ballon d'Or, which will be announced on 13 January. Conte is on the shortlist for the FIFA World Coach of the Year for Men's Football award.

#### UEFA milestones and competition statistics

- Cristiano Ronaldo is the competition's seven-goal leading scorer. The group stage record is eight in a season, held jointly by Ruud van Nistelrooy (2004/05), Filippo Inzaghi and Hernán Crespo (both 2002/03).
- Ronaldo was the 12-goal top scorer in the 2012/13 UEFA Champions League. He has found the net 26 times in his last 21 matches in the competition, registering 55 times in all.
- Ángel Di María and Thiago Motta have each made a competition high of four assists apiece.
- Luka Modrić is a booking away from a suspension after picking up two yellow cards.

#### General information

- Ronaldo (five), Karim Benzema (three) and Gareth Bale (two) have scored ten goals between them in Madrid's last two games, a 7-3 victory over Sevilla FC and Saturday's 3-2 win at Rayo Vallecano de Madrid.
- Madrid responded to their 2-1 Clásico loss at FC Barcelona on 26 October by defeating Sevilla four days later. Ronaldo struck a hat-trick and Bale, playing 90 minutes for the first time for the club, scored twice.
- Ronaldo, Madrid's fifth highest all-time scorer, has struck 23 goals in his last 15 outings for the club. He signed a three-year contract that ties him to Madrid until 2018 on 15 September.
- Xabi Alonso, back from a broken foot, made his first appearance of the season against Sevilla and played the first half against Rayo Vallecano.
- Carlo Ancelotti's seven-match unbeaten start as Madrid boss ended on 28 September with a 1-0 derby defeat at home to Club Atlético de Madrid.
- Benzema ended his 16-month international goal drought as France defeated Australia 6-0 in a friendly on 11 October and was on target again as Les Bleus ended their qualifying campaign with a 3-0 win at home to Finland.
- Bale and Ronaldo have been nominated for the 2014 FIFA Ballon d'Or, which will be announced on 13 January. Ancelotti is on the shortlist for the FIFA World Coach of the Year for Men's Football award.

- A combative and versatile midfielder, Conte also weighed in with his share of goals – usually spectacular.
- Made Serie A debut with hometown club Lecce aged 16 in 1985/86 but was not a regular until 1988/89 when his side returned to the top flight after two seasons away. Joined Juventus in November 1991.
- Spent the next 13 seasons at Juve, later describing the famous black-and-white shirt as his "second skin". Won five Scudettos, the UEFA Champions League in 1995/96 and the UEFA Cup in 1992/93 in addition to triumphs in the UEFA Super Cup, Italian Cup and a European/South American Cup, wearing the captain's armband from 1996. Capped 20 times by Italy, he was part of the squads that finished runners-up at the 1994 FIFA World Cup and UEFA EURO 2000.
- Started coaching career as assistant at Siena in 2005, taking over Serie B side Arezzo the following season. After leading Bari and Siena to the top flight in 2009 and 2011 respectively, he signed a two-year contract with Juventus.
- Wasted no time in revamping the squad and enjoyed a debut season to remember as the Bianconeri claimed the Scudetto without losing a single game, suffering their sole defeat of the season against SSC Napoli in the Coppa Italia final. After signing a new contract until 2015, he duly guided Juventus to a second successive title in 2013.

- One of only six people to have lifted the European Champion Clubs' Cup as both a player and coach. A combative midfielder, he helped Roma win the 1983 Serie A title and four Italian Cups before joining Milan in 1986 where he added two more league championships, as well as back-to-back European Cup triumphs in 1989 and 1990.
- Began coaching in 1995 with a year at Reggiana, earning them promotion from Serie B, before two seasons at Parma. Replaced Marcello Lippi at Juventus in February 1999 and returned to San Siro as coach of Milan in 2001.
- During eight seasons in charge, won the UEFA Champions League in 2003 and 2007, but lost the 2005 final on penalties to Liverpool FC after leading 3-0. Milan also won a Serie A title, a Coppa Italia and the 2007 FIFA Club World Cup.
- Resigned on 31 May 2009 and was named as Chelsea's new manager the following day. His first season in London ended with the club winning the league and cup double for the first time. Dismissed at the end of his second campaign, Ancelotti took charge of PSG in December 2011.
- In his one full season in the French capital, 2012/13, Ancelotti steered PSG to their first Ligue 1 title in 19 years before leaving to take over at Madrid on a three-year contract.

## Competition facts

---

### UEFA Champions League: Did you know?

- Last season Chelsea FC became the first defending champions to fail to get through a group stage since the UEFA Champions League began. (This record, like the others, includes the seasons between 1999/2000 and 2002/03 that featured a second group stage). In 1992/93, FC Barcelona were the reigning European Champion Clubs' Cup holders and lost 4-3 on aggregate in the second round to PFC CSKA Moskva.
- No team has successfully defended the UEFA Champions League trophy with AC Milan (1989, 1990) the last club to win consecutive European Cups. Milan (1994, 1995), AFC Ajax (1995, 1996), Juventus (1996, 1997) and Manchester United FC (2008, 2009) have all returned to the UEFA Champions League final as holders only to lose.
- S.S. Lazio goalkeeper Marco Ballotta is the oldest player to compete in the UEFA Champions League having featured against Real Madrid CF on matchday six in 2007/08 aged 43 years and 252 days. Alessandro Costacurta is the oldest outfield player; the Milan defender was 40 years and 211 days when he played against AEK Athens FC in 2006/07.
- Ryan Giggs is the oldest player to score in the competition, aged 37 years and 289 days, in Manchester United's 1-1 draw at SL Benfica on 14 September 2011.
- Celestine Babayaro is the youngest player to have appeared; he was 16 years and 87 days when he started for RSC Anderlecht against FC Steaua Bucureşti on 23 November 1994. He was sent off in the 37th minute.
- Peter Ofori-Quaye is the youngest player to have scored in the UEFA Champions League, aged 17 years and 195 days. He found the net in Olympiacos FC's 5-1 defeat at Rosenborg BK on 1 October 1997.
- Lionel Messi became the first player to score five goals in a match in Barcelona's 7-1 win against Bayer 04 Leverkusen on 7 March 2012. Ten players, including Messi, have scored four times in a game, most recently Zlatan Ibrahimović for Paris Saint-Germain on matchday three this season.
- Barcelona have finished as group winners on 14 occasions, one more than Manchester United.
- Barcelona hold the record for successive wins in the UEFA Champions League proper with nine, between 18 September 2002 and 18 February 2003. RSC Anderlecht's 12 straight defeats (10 December 2003 to 23 November 2005) is also a competition record.
- Five teams have recorded six successive victories in a UEFA Champions League group stage: Milan (1992/93), Paris Saint-Germain (1994/95), FC Spartak Moskva (1995/96), Barcelona (2002/03, first group stage) and Real Madrid (2011/12).
- Fifteen teams have gone through a UEFA Champions League group stage without picking up a single point, most recently Villarreal CF, FC Oţelul Galaţi and GNK Dinamo Zagreb in 2011/12.
- Barcelona scored 20 goals in the 2011/12 group stage, equalling Manchester United's competition record from 1998/99. Barcelona scored 19 times in the 1999/2000 first group stage, a tally matched by Real Madrid last season.
- Only RC Deportivo La Coruña (2004/05) and Maccabi Haifa FC (2009/10) have failed to score in a group stage.
- Dinamo Zagreb conceded 22 goals in the 2011/12 group stage, a new record that was equalled by FC Nordsjælland last season. The previous highest total was 19, shared by MŠK Žilina (2010/11), Debreceni VSC (2009/10), FC Dynamo Kyiv (2007/08) and Ferencvárosi TC (1995/96).
- No team has ever gone through a UEFA Champions League group stage without conceding a goal. Milan (1992/93), Ajax (1995/96), Juventus (1996/97 and 2004/05), Chelsea (2005/06), Liverpool FC (2005/06), Villarreal (2005/06) and Manchester United (2010/11) all let in just one.
- Before their 3-1 win against Sporting Clube de Portugal on matchday six of the 2006/07 campaign, Spartak Moskva went 22 games without a victory in the competition.
- The lowest total for a team qualifying from the group stage is seven points. The first to do it since three points for a win was introduced in 1995/96 were Legia Warszawa that same season before Dynamo Kyiv managed it in 1999/2000 and Liverpool in 2001/02. FC Lokomotiv Moskva and eventual finalists Juventus both progressed with seven points in 2002/03, as did Rangers FC and SV Werder Bremen in 2005/06.
- Only two teams have ever won the UEFA Champions League on home soil: Borussia Dortmund (1997, final in Munich) and Juventus (1996, final in Rome), while Manchester United lost the 2011 final in London and 12 months later Bayern were beaten in the showpiece in their own stadium, the Fußball Arena München.

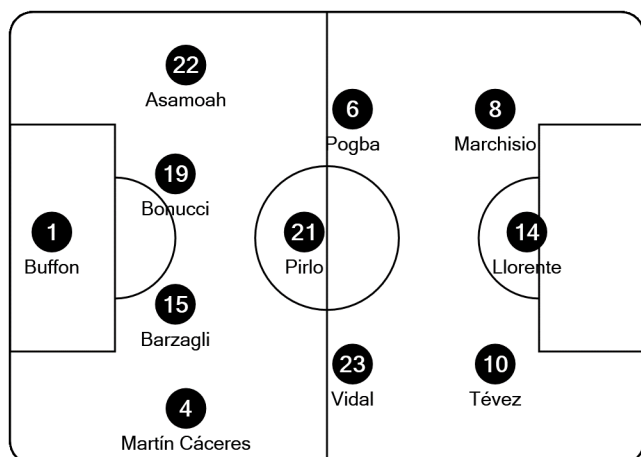

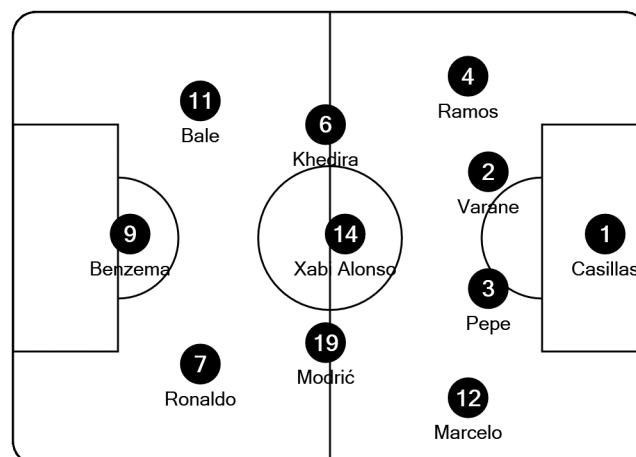

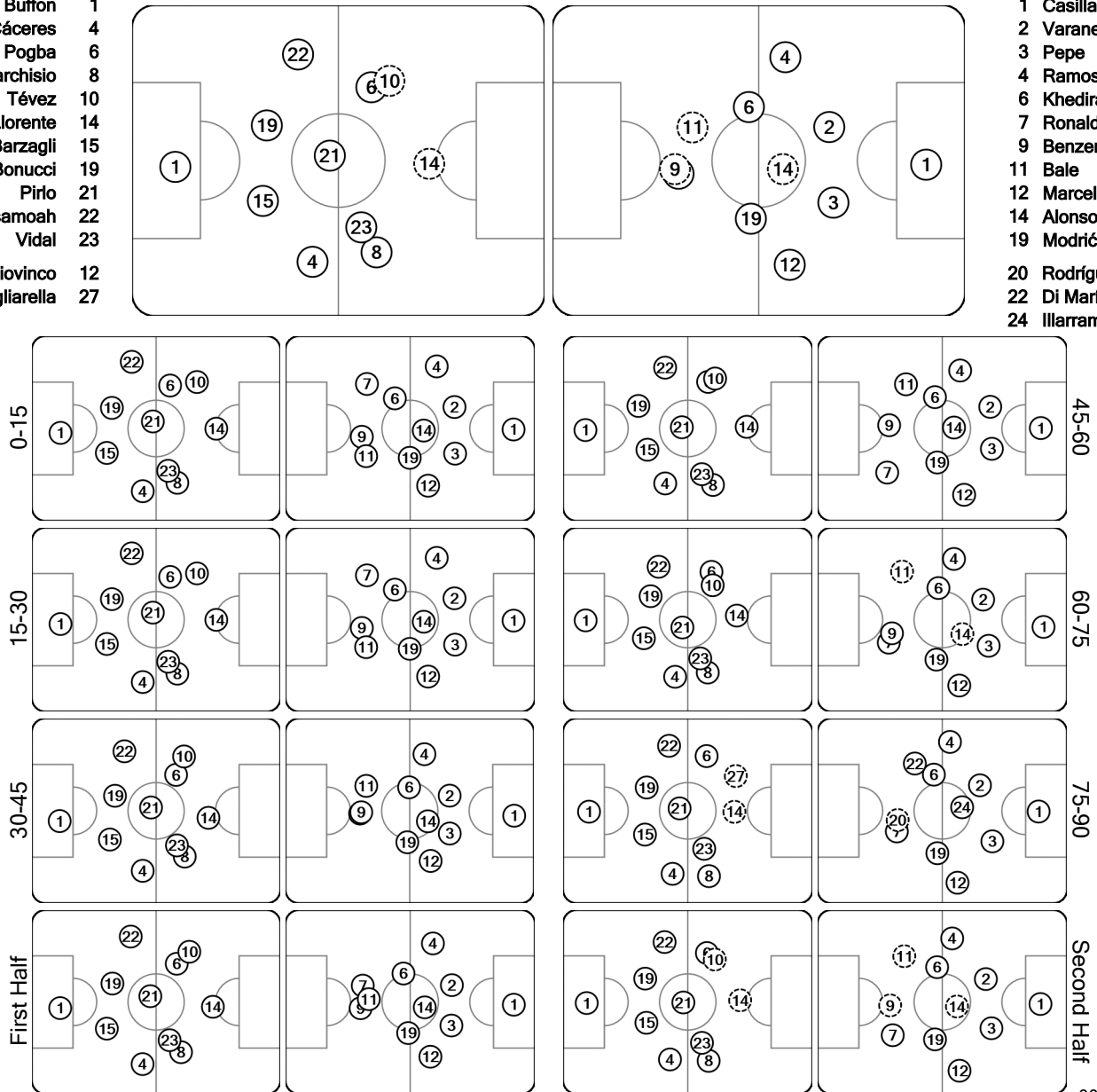
