## Match background

---

Borussia Dortmund's first home game in the 2013/14 UEFA Champions League puts them up against Olympique de Marseille who have memories of a recent victory at the BVB Stadion.

- Both teams have ground to make up in Group F having both lost 2-1 on matchday one, Dortmund going down at SSC Napoli and Marseille falling to Arsenal FC at the Stade Vélodrome.

### Previous meetings

- The teams met in the group stage two years ago when Marseille won 3-0 at home and 3-2 away.
- At the Stade Vélodrome, the first competitive fixture between the teams, OM took the points thanks to goals from André Ayew (20, 69 pen) either side of Loïc Rémy's 62nd-minute effort. The hosts had substitute Jordan Ayew sent off late on.
- That last encounter, on matchday six, propelled Marseille to the round of 16 in dramatic circumstances. Dortmund, still with hopes of qualifying themselves, built a 2-0 lead through Jakub Błaszczykowski (23) and a Mats Hummels penalty (32). Marseille responded through Rémy (45+4) and André Ayew (84) but were still going out until substitute Mathieu Valbuena hit an 87th-minute winner.

- The lineups on 6 December 2011 were:

**Marseille:** Mandanda, Azpilicueta, Diawara, N'Koulou, Traoré, Amalfitano, Diarra, Mbia (Cheyrou 46), A Ayew, Lucho González (J Ayew 67), Rémy (Valbuena 73).

- That was Dortmund's first home defeat in seven games against French visitors; previously they had recorded three wins and three draws. In total their 14 games against French opponents ended W4 D5 L5.

- It was Marseille's first victory in five visits to Germany and only the second time they had found the net. They have since gone down 2-0 away to FC Bayern München (a 4-0 aggregate defeat) in the 2011/12 quarter-final, and 2-0 at VfL Borussia Mönchengladbach in last season's UEFA Europa League group stage after a 2-2 home draw in which Jordan Ayew scored.

- Marseille's overall record in 14 fixtures against German sides is W5 D3 L6 (W1 D2 L4 in Germany).

### Match background

- Dortmund, who are in their ninth participation in the UEFA Champions League, will be looking to go one step further than last year. In their most successful campaign since winning the 1997 UEFA Champions League, they remained unbeaten until the semi-final second leg when they went down 2-0 at Real Madrid CF.

- It did not prevent Jürgen Klopp's team, 4-1 winners in the home leg, from advancing to the Wembley final where FC Bayern München beat them 2-1.

- The Madrid home win maintained Dortmund's 100% record at their own stadium in the campaign and was their second success there against the Merengues, who they had beaten 2-1 in the group stage. They also saw off AFC Ajax and Manchester City FC, both 1-0, and in the knockout rounds won 3-0 at home to FC Shakhtar Donetsk (5-2 aggregate), and 3-2 against Málaga CF after the away leg had finished goalless.

- Marseille are also in their ninth UEFA Champions League campaign with last season's absence ending a run of five successive years in the competition. The quarter-final appearance two years ago was their first since becoming the tournament's inaugural winners in 1993.

- In last season's UEFA Europa League group stage, OM lost at Mönchengladbach and AEL Limassol FC (0-3) and drew 2-2 at Fenerbahçe SK.

### Team ties

- Pierre-Emerick Aubameyang has played for four clubs in France: LOSC Lille and Dijon FCO (2009/10), AS Monaco FC (2010/11) and AS Saint-Étienne (2011-13). His record in seven meetings with OM is one win, three draws and three defeats.

- Aubameyang gave Gabon the lead against Souleymane Diawara's Senegal in a friendly played in Sannois Saint-Gratien on 17 November 2010, Senegal recovering to win 2-1.

- Aubameyang scored the second-half goal that give Gabon a 1-0 win against Saber Khalifa's Tunisia during the group stage of the 2012 Africa Cup of Nations.

- On 6 February 2013, Valbuena scored the opening goal in France's 2-1 defeat in a friendly against Germany at the Stade de France. Hummels and İlkay Gündoğan featured for the visitors.

#### General information

- Dortmund beat SC Freiburg 5-0 on Saturday after the visitors were reduced to ten men with the score 1-0 just before the interval. Oliver Kirch made his first appearance of the season as a half-time replacement for Sven Bender.
- Dortmund have broken the deadlock in each of their last 15 league outings, breaking the previous club record of 13.
- The Schwarzgelben have scored in their last 31 top-flight matches and the past 24 away from home.
- Marcel Schmelzer was ruled out for three weeks after tearing his thigh on Friday.
- BVB needed extra time to see off second-tier TSV 1860 München 2-0 last Tuesday, sealing a place in the German Cup last 16. Weidenfeller's understudy Mitchell Langerak kept his third clean sheet in as many starts this term.
- Dortmund began the season with four successive Bundesliga wins for the first time since 2001/02, when they went on to secure the title. They stretched the winning start to five, a club record, before a 1-1 draw at Nürnberg.
- Sebastian Kehl suffered an ankle ligament injury in training on 15 September and was ruled out for six weeks. Łukasz Piszczek, out until at least the end of November, had hip and groin surgery during the summer. İlykay Gündoğan has been sidelined since mid-August due to compression of the spine.
- Klopp's side condemned Josep Guardiola to defeat in his first game as Bayern coach, winning the German Super Cup 4-2 on 27 July.

#### General information

- Mathieu Valbuena and André Ayew opened their 2013/14 accounts on Saturday as OM won 2-0 at Lorient.
- Left-back Jérémy Morel is expected to miss the trip to Dortmund after spraining his right knee during Marseille's goalless draw at Bastia on 21 September.
- Mendy scored his first professional goal and Imbula was on target with his first for the club as OM won 2-1 at home to AS Saint-Étienne on 24 September.
- André-Pierre Gignac scored in OM's first three games this term, his best start to a season, but not since. He won his first cap since the 2010 FIFA World Cup in France's 0-0 draw with Georgia on 6 September.
- Lucas Mendes marked his first appearance of the campaign – a 2-1 defeat by AS Monaco FC on 1 September – with his first goal in 33 games. The 23-year-old's only previous strike for OM came on his club debut last October. He made it two in as many outings with a late equaliser in the 1-1 draw at Toulouse FC next time out.
- Of Marseille's 21 wins in Ligue 1 last season, 18 were by a single goal and 12 ended 1-0.

---

- Having spent his early career in the lower leagues and failed to break into Eintracht's first team, Klopp turned professional with Mainz, starting off as a striker before becoming a no-nonsense defender. Never played in the top flight but made 325 second-division appearances from 1990 to 2001, setting a club record by scoring 52 goals.
- 'Kloppo', as he is known in Germany, was appointed Mainz's caretaker coach on 28 February 2001, helping the club avoid relegation to the third tier. Duly won a permanent contract and built Mainz into one of the strongest clubs in the 2. Bundesliga; narrowly missed out on promotion in 2002 and 2003, Mainz losing out to Eintracht by a single goal in the latter campaign.
- Finally took Mainz into the top flight for the first time in 2004 and kept them in the Bundesliga until 2007, taking them into the 2005/06 UEFA Cup via the UEFA Fair Play ranking – they lost to eventual winners Sevilla FC in the first round.
- After another promotion near-miss in 2007/08 Klopp – whose enthusiasm and passion, plus work as a TV pundit, have made him popular all over Germany – left for Dortmund. Took them to sixth in his first season, led them into the UEFA Europa League the next year and then, with a squad full of exciting young talent, oversaw league title wins in 2010/11 and 2011/12, adding the German Cup in the latter campaign.
- Earned even greater admiration in the 2012/13 season as he steered Dortmund all the way to the UEFA Champions League final at Wembley, where they lost to FC Bayern München.

### Olympique de Marseille: Élie Baup

---

- The Pyrenean-born Baup's promising career as a goalkeeper ended at the age of 20 when a car crash left him with two broken bones in his neck.
- Having gained formal coaching qualifications, Baup put his theory into practice with amateur side Castelnaudary, doing enough to attract the attention of Toulouse, who put him in charge of their youth academy in 1984; Fabien Barthez was among his discoveries, and he was to move to St-Étienne in a similar capacity in 1991, briefly taking command of the senior team in 1996.
- Hired by Bordeaux in 1997, Baup embarked on the most successful spell of his career, with his Girondins selection pipping Marseille to the 1998/99 French title then beating FC Lorient 3-0 in the 2001/02 League Cup final, a victory best remembered for a tremendous Pauleta bicycle kick.
- Having regularly led Bordeaux in Europe, Baup was to return to UEFA competitions in subsequent spells with St-Étienne (2004-06) and Toulouse (2006-08), but took time out after his Nantes side were relegated from Ligue 1 at the end of the 2008/09 campaign.
- Following a successful spell as a TV pundit, Baup returned to coaching, replacing Didier Deschamps at Marseille in July 2012; his side started the 2012/13 season with a record six straight Ligue 1 wins en route to qualifying for the UEFA Champions League group stage as runners-up to Paris Saint-Germain FC.

## Competition facts

---

### UEFA Champions League: Did you know?

- Last season Chelsea FC became the first defending champions to fail to get through a group stage since the UEFA Champions League began. (This record, like the others, includes the seasons between 1999/2000 and 2002/03 that featured a second group stage). In 1992/93, FC Barcelona were the reigning European Champion Clubs' Cup holders and lost 4-3 on aggregate in the second round to PFC CSKA Moskva.
- No team has successfully defended the UEFA Champions League trophy with AC Milan (1989, 1990) the last club to win consecutive European Cups. Milan (1994, 1995), AFC Ajax (1995, 1996), Juventus (1996, 1997) and Manchester United FC (2008, 2009) have all returned to the UEFA Champions League final as holders only to lose.
- S.S. Lazio goalkeeper Marco Ballotta is the oldest player to compete in the UEFA Champions League having featured against Real Madrid CF on matchday six in 2007/08 aged 43 years and 252 days. Alessandro Costacurta is the oldest outfield player; the Milan defender was 40 years and 211 days when he played against AEK Athens FC in 2006/07.
- Ryan Giggs is the oldest player to score in the competition, aged 37 years and 289 days, in Manchester United's 1-1 draw at SL Benfica on 14 September 2011.
- Celestine Babayaro is the youngest player to have appeared; he was 16 years and 87 days when he started for RSC Anderlecht against FC Steaua Bucureşti on 23 November 1994. He was sent off in the 37th minute.
- Peter Ofori-Quaye is the youngest player to have scored in the UEFA Champions League, aged 17 years and 195 days. He found the net in Olympiacos FC's 5-1 defeat at Rosenborg BK on 1 October 1997.
- Lionel Messi became the first player to score five goals in a match in Barcelona's 7-1 win against Bayer 04 Leverkusen on 7 March 2012. Eight players, including Messi, have scored four times in a game, most recently Mario Gomez for FC Bayern München on matchday eight in 2011/12.
- Barcelona have finished as group winners on 14 occasions, one more than Manchester United.
- Barcelona hold the record for successive wins in the UEFA Champions League proper with nine, between 18 September 2002 and 18 February 2003. RSC Anderlecht's 12 straight defeats (10 December 2003 to 23 November 2005) is also a competition record.
- Five teams have recorded six successive victories in a UEFA Champions League group stage: Milan (1992/93), Paris Saint-Germain FC (1994/95), FC Spartak Moskva (1995/96), Barcelona (2002/03, first group stage) and Real Madrid (2011/12).
- Fifteen teams have gone through a UEFA Champions League group stage without picking up a single point, most recently Villarreal CF, FC Oţelul Galaţi and GNK Dinamo Zagreb in 2011/12.
- Barcelona scored 20 goals in the 2011/12 group stage, equalling Manchester United's competition record from 1998/99. Barcelona scored 19 times in the 1999/2000 first group stage, a tally matched by Real Madrid last season.
- Only RC Deportivo La Coruña (2004/05) and Maccabi Haifa FC (2009/10) have failed to score in a group stage.
- Dinamo Zagreb conceded 22 goals in the 2011/12 group stage, a new record that was equalled by FC Nordsjælland last season. The previous highest total was 19, shared by MŠK Žilina (2010/11), Debreceni VSC (2009/10), FC Dynamo Kyiv (2007/08) and Ferencvárosi TC (1995/96).
- No team has ever gone through a UEFA Champions League group stage without conceding a goal. Milan (1992/93), Ajax (1995/96), Juventus (1996/97 and 2004/05), Chelsea (2005/06), Liverpool FC (2005/06), Villarreal (2005/06) and Manchester United (2010/11) all let in just one.
- Before their 3-1 win against Sporting Clube de Portugal on matchday six of the 2006/07 campaign, Spartak Moskva went 22 games without a victory in the competition.
- The lowest total for a team qualifying from the group stage is seven points. The first to do it since three points for a win was introduced in 1995/96 were Legia Warszawa that same season before Dynamo Kyiv managed it in 1999/2000 and Liverpool in 2001/02. FC Lokomotiv Moskva and eventual finalists Juventus both progressed with seven points in 2002/03, as did Rangers FC and SV Werder Bremen in 2005/06.
- Only two teams have ever won the UEFA Champions League on home soil: Borussia Dortmund (1997, final in Munich) and Juventus (1996, final in Rome), while Manchester United lost the 2011 final in London and 12 months later Bayern were beaten in the showpiece in their own stadium, the Fußball Arena München.

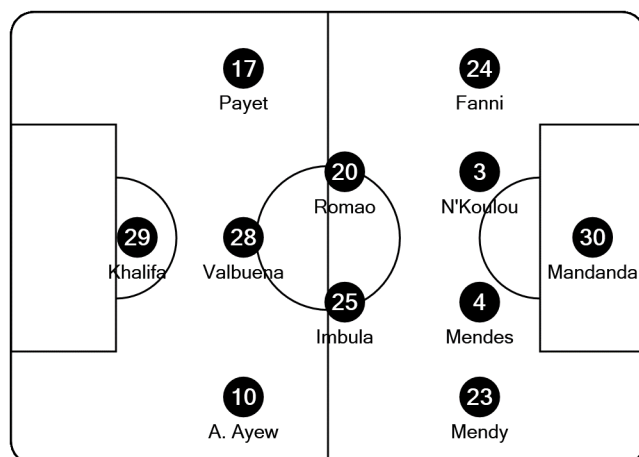

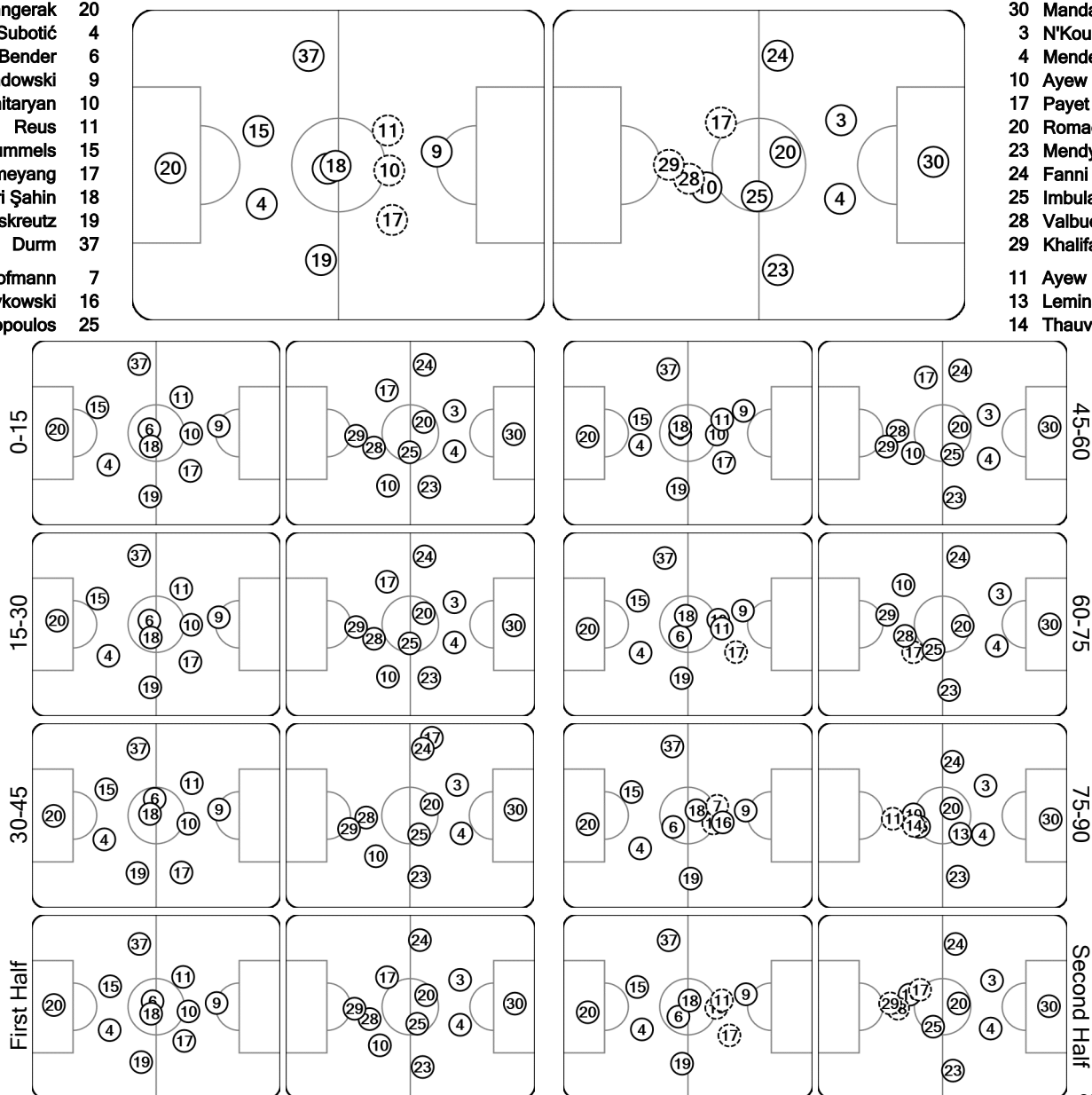
